

## 83rd ANNIVERSARY COMMEMORATION Fri 1st– Sun 3rd September 2023

\*unfortunately the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary was postponed in 2020



On Sat 7<sup>th</sup> Sept 1940, between 6-30am and 11-00am, 1,984 Dunera Boys arrived at Hay Railway Station in 48 carriages of 4 steam trains. They then travelled to Hay Internment and POW Camps 7 and 8.

The Dunera Museum has had a refurbishment in 2022 with the redesign of the exhibition layout and is now divided into two distinct stories creating an important asset for Hay. The Museum is open from 8am-6pm daily

Follow 'Dunera Way' from the station to Camps 7 and 8 by car convoy. Tour of Camps 7 and 8, Racecourse/Showground, Garrison areas. Stop at Dunera Commemorative Obelisk in Dunera Way. The obelisk was unveiled in 1990 for the 50th anniversary.

**AFTERNOON - Free time to visit the various historic War Memorial Museums**

- **Hay Gaol Museum** – The site of first Military Hospital where sick Dunera Boys were sent before the Camp hospital was completed.
- **Shear Outback Museum** – A history of the Australian sheep shearing and wool industry. Shearing demo and talk at 9.30 am & 1.30 pm every day
- **Bishop's Lodge** – 1890 historic house and garden. Open 9 am –5 pm. (Monday –Friday), 9 am -12 pm Saturday
- **Hay General Cemetery, Jewish Section** – Visit the grave of Menasche Bodner, the only Dunera Boy to die in Hay

**6.30 pm DINNER** -Bishop's Lodge Restaurant – a la carte menu – enjoy a relaxing dinner in a top class restaurant
